Following the massive coverage of the Men's and Women's Ashes cricket tour to England this is a great way to kick off the 2015/16 Summer of Cricket in Tamworth.

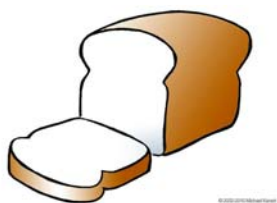
**Tintinhull Public School has formed a partnership with Bakers Delight, Tamworth, as a part of the Doughraiser program.**
