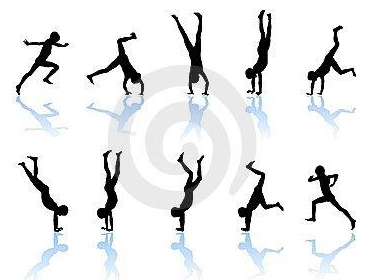

Term 3 Gymnastics

Gymnastics is a wonderful opportunity for students to enhance their balance and coordination skills. In Term 3, on Wednesdays all students will have the opportunity to participate in a gymnastics program with a qualified coach. As part of the Sporting Schools Funding and our Fun-Run Fundraising the school will subsidise 90% of the cost for the gymnastics program per student. This means a whole term of gymnastics will cost parents just \$10 per student (this is equivalent to \$1 per week). We are very lucky to be able to run this program at such a low cost to students as in previous years it has been a costly program.

The payment of \$10 per student is payable to the office by Wednesday the 20th of July (our first gymnastics day). Students who do not pay their \$10 will not be attending these sessions. All students are required to wear full sports uniform on Wednesdays for the whole of Term 3.
