We have, and will be, purchasing games and equipment for the students to play with and would like to advise that we would like them to keep their own toys and belongings at home, because at the moment it is causing some issues in our playground. Also if any student brings an item from home the Education Department is not responsible for it if it is damaged, stolen or broken.

Allergies - We have a few of our children who have nut allergies. It would be appreciated if you could reframe from sending in any foods with a nut base, especially peanut butter. One of our junior students is extremely allergic to all nuts and it can be very dangerous for them to come in contact with any product that has nuts in them. Your consideration in this matter is greatly appreciated.

Gymnastics - is a wonderful opportunity for students to enhance their balance and coordination skills. In Term 3, on Wednesdays all students will have the opportunity to participate in a gymnastics program with a qualified coach. As part of the Sporting Schools Funding and our Fun-Run Fundraising the school will subsidise 90% of the cost for the gymnastics program per student. This means a whole term of gymnastics will cost parents just \$10 per student (this is equivalent to \$1 per week).
